Christmas tree with a difference

You will need:

- 22 x 44mm planed pine, cut to
- Two 1 500mm pieces (sides)
- Two 960mm pieces (top and bottom)
- 6mm x 40mm chipboard screws
- Fishing line
- Alcolin Ultra Wood Glue
- Drill and 3mm drill bit

Instructions:

1. Measure and make marks 100mm apart along the length of the two side pieces; drilling a hole at each mark.
2. Use Alcolin Ultra Wood Glue to glue and screw the top and bottom between the ends of the side pieces.
3. Thread fishing line from left to right through all the holes and tighten it.
4. Make the Christmas decorations by gluing multi-coloured, patterned paper to cardboard – some are simple circles, others are folded to create a 3D effect. The mini 'trees' are straws cut in different lengths and glued together.
5. Hang the decorations on the tightened fishing lines and hang the frame!
